

**HOOBIES QUARTERLY MEETING
OCTOBER 20, 2010**

Bill Williams, Vice President, opened the quarterly meeting at 4:45pm, October 20, 2010, and welcomed everyone in attendance.

VP Williams asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as written (copies were emailed to membership prior to meeting). Motion to accept minutes as written with one correction of a misspelled word was made by Jack Reed and seconded by Floyd Shaw.

Treasurer Twiford gave the treasurer's report, stating all bills paid and the treasury had a balance of \$1313.39 with a new deposit to be made of \$200.50, which was the result of merchandise the Hoobies received from the Robert Wrenn Golf Tournament that was auctioned off to the highest bidder. Motion was made by Sam Twiford to accept treasurer's report and seconded by Red Copeland. Motion carried.

VP Williams called on committee chairmen to give their report:

Dwayne Crank, Social Committee, gave a report on the upcoming gin tournament to be held Nov. 5, 2010.

Tommy Brite, Tournament Committee, reported that all golfing tournaments are over for this year. He thanked the Hoobies for participating in the different tournaments that were held this year.

Bud Tardiff, Rules Committee member, stated there were no new rules for consideration at this time.

VP Williams stated that it was time to start thinking about the new year and election of officers. He appointed Paul Newbold, Tommy Brite, and John King to the committee to come up with a list of names for the different offices and give their report to the Executive Committee by Dec. 5, 2010, at which time the list will be posted at The Pines and emailed to the members prior to the election which will be held at our Jan. 5, 2011 meeting. Paul Newbold was appointed chairman of the committee.

Paul Newbold suggested three changes in our current by-laws:

1. Article 5 --- eliminate President and Secretary having to attend committee meetings for the Rules Committee.
2. Separate the offices of Secretary and Treasurer, to allow more involvement from the membership.
3. Eliminate voting rights for the chairman of the Rules Committee on the Executive Board. The Rules Committee Chairman will continue as a board member but will become a non-voting member.

Vice President Williams stated that these changes must be voted on by membership at our next stated quarterly meeting, Jan. 5, 2011.

With no further business a motion was made by Sam Twiford to adjourn with a second by Larry Payne. Motion carried and the meeting closed at 5:20pm.
